

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
VILLAGE OF MARCELLUS
HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL
ON OCTOBER 7, 2015**

Trustee Tallman opened the special meeting at 10:00 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to open sealed bids for Scotch Hill Sidewalk Project.

Village Clerk Dawn O'Hara informed everyone that a copy of the legal notice advertising for bids was available for public inspection.

The Village was provided \$50,000 in funding from Onondaga County Community Development Division. The Board had previously made a decision to install approximately 800 linear feet of ADA compliant sidewalks on the south side of Scotch Hill Road, from North Street to the Village line.

The Village Treasurer opened the bids that were received and announced the bids as listed below. All of the bid packets received included the required 5% bid bonds/deposit in their bid packets.
