

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
VILLAGE OF MARCELLUS
HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL
ON AUGUST 21, 2014**

Mayor Curtin opened the special meeting at 10:00 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to open sealed bids for Scotch Hill Curbing Project.

Village Clerk Dawn O'Hara informed everyone that a copy of the legal notice advertising for bids was available for public inspection.

The Village had been provided \$50,000 in funding from Onondaga County under a program whereby monies were set aside by the County Legislature for Villages that were not eligible for "Save the Rain" funding. The Board made a decision to install approximately 800 linear feet of granite curbing on the south side of Scotch Hill Road, from North Street to the Village line.

The Village Clerk opened the two bids that were received. The Village Treasurer announced the bids as listed below. Both of the bid packets that were received included the required 5% bid bonds in their bid packet.

Bidders were advised that the bids would be turned over to Village Engineers, Barton & Loguidice, for their review and recommendation to the Village Board.

Since both bids were over the estimate that the Board had anticipated for the project, the Board will most likely reject both bids and rebid the project.
