

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
VILLAGE OF MARCELLUS
HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL
ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2014**

Trustee Tallman opened the special meeting at 10:00 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to open sealed bids for Scotch Hill Curbing Project.

A prior bid opening was held in August. The Board rejected both of those bids, due to the bids being too high.

Village Clerk Dawn O'Hara informed everyone that a copy of the legal notice advertising for bids was available for public inspection.

The Village was provided \$50,000 in funding from Onondaga County under a program whereby monies were set aside by the County Legislature for Villages that were not eligible for "Save the Rain" funding. The Board made a decision to install approximately 800 linear feet of granite curbing on the south side of Scotch Hill Road, from North Street to the Village line.

The Village Treasurer opened the three bids that were received and announced the bids as listed below. All of the bid packets received included the required 5% bid bonds/deposit in their bid packets.

Apparent low bidder was K. Fellows Excavation.

Bidders were informed that the bids would be turned over to Village Engineers, Barton & Loguidice, for their review and recommendation to the Village Board for their September board meeting.
