

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

Mayor Curtin opened the informational meeting at 7:00p.m.

The Board will continue to work on those initiatives, toward a solution to the drainage problems in the village and will continue to seek input from residents affected by stormwater. Mayor Curtin also explained that the Village is limited as to what it can do on private property.
