Chapter 233 – Television

[Adopted, December 27, 2012, as Ch. 233 of the Code]

Article I Satellite Dish Installation and Maintenance

Section 233-1 – Satellite Dish Installation and Maintenance

a. Satellite dishes (which are external electronic devices to receive television signals from communications satellites for on premises television and which devices may be attached to a building or may be standing free) are permitted provided the following conditions are complied with:

- 1) Prior to installation of a satellite dish larger than two (2) feet in diameter, a permit is obtained from the Code Enforcement Officer by application on forms to be provided by the Village Clerk
- 2) No satellite dish shall be installed in the front yard or side yard on a lot where building is located. Any satellite dish installed in a rear yard where a building (exclusive of an accessory building) is located must be at least eight (8) feet from the rear and side yard lines and the building foundation.
- 3) A satellite dish not attached to a building may not exceed eight (8) feet in diameter. A satellite dish attached to a building may not exceed four (4) feet in diameter, and cannot be higher than the highest point in the roof of the building to which it is attached.

b. Violations and Penalties. The local Justice Court shall have Jurisdiction for violations based on the issuance of an appearance ticket by the Code Enforcement Officer. Each week of violation shall constitute a separate violation. A fine not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) may imposed for each week of violation.
