HOT WORK PERMIT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- A) Complete all applicable sections of this application.
- B) Sign and date the bottom of the application.
- C) Submit the following required items with your completed application (Some may not be applicable to your project):
 - □ A complete description of the project
 - □ Contractor Insurance Certificates with the Village of Marcellus as certificate holder:
 - o General Contractor's Liability Insurance Certificate
 - General Contractor's Workman's Compensation Insurance Certificate or exemption (Form C-105.2, GSI-105.2, U-26.3, CE-200, SI-12 or BP-1)
- D) Projects typically take 3-5 days to review.
- E) The permit must be approved and paid for before work can commence. The permit fee will be doubled if work is started without an approved permit.
- F) Length of validity. Permits shall be valid for up to 90 days from date of issue. An extension may be granted, provided that such an application shall be made in writing prior to the expiration date and good cause is shown.
- G) Hot work shall only be conducted in areas designed or authorized for that purpose by the personnel responsible for a Hot Work Program.

Hot work shall not be conducted in the following areas unless approval has been obtained from the Code official:

- 1. Areas where the sprinkler system is impaired.
- 2. Areas where there exists the potential of an explosive atmosphere, such as locations where flammable gases, liquids or vapors are present.
- 3. Areas with readily ignitable materials, such as storage of large quantities of bulk sulfur, baled paper, cotton, lint, dust or loose combustible materials.
- 4. On board ships at dock or ships under construction or repair.
- 5. At other locations as specified by the Code official.
- H) Qualifications of operators: A permit for hot work operations shall not be issued unless the individuals in charge of performing such operations are capable of performing such operations safely. Demonstration of a working knowledge of the provisions of this chapter shall constitute acceptable evidence of compliance with this requirement.
- Records: The individual responsible for the hot work area shall maintain "pre-work check" reports in accordance with Section 3504.3.1. Such reports shall be maintained on the premises for not less than 48 hours after work is complete.
