

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
VILLAGE OF MARCELLUS
HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL
ON NOVEMBER 27, 2017**

Mayor Curtin asked for a motion to open the public hearing at 7:00 p.m. Trustee Cox made a motion to open the hearing, seconded by Trustee Tallman. All board members voted aye, and the public hearing was opened.

The Village Clerk read the legal notice of the public hearing to those in attendance.

Mayor Curtin explained that the purpose of the public hearing was to allow all interested parties the opportunity to be heard regarding Local Law #4 of 2017, which will amend Local Law #3 of 2016, Chapter 89, Flood Damage Prevention, by adding Subsection 3.2(3), Letter of Map Revision.

Mayor Curtin mentioned that a physical change to the Village of Marcellus' Flood Insurance Rate Map had been made by FEMA. The NYSDEC, as the enforcing agency, recommended that the Village formally adopt a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR). It is necessary that the Village formally adopt the LOMR before permits based on the information on the Letter of Map Revision can be issued.

Mayor Curtin informed the public that Chapter 89, Section 3.2 of the Village of Marcellus Code of Ordinances, Flood Damage Prevention, will be amended by adding the following Subsection, to wit:

- (3) Letter of Map Revision, Case Number 17-02-1132P, effective March 20, 2018, amending Panels 36067C0302F of the Flood Insurance Rate Map, Flood Insurance Study Profiles 156P, and Floodway Data Table 9 of the Flood Insurance Study.

Mayor Curtin asked if there were any comments from the public. There were none.

Mayor Curtin then asked for a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Trustee Cox made the motion, seconded by Trustee Tallman. Mayor Curtin called for a vote. All board members voted aye and the meeting was adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
