
EMERGENCY ORDER

WHEREAS, at 7:30 P.M., on March 23, 2020. A Local State of Emergency has been declared pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, Article 2B, and current Executive Orders of the New York State Governor's Office in response to the COVID-19 virus outbreak in and around the Village of Marcellus; and

WHEREAS, due to the potential danger to the health, safety and welfare of the general public in the Village of Marcellus and to Village of Marcellus personnel as a result of the COVID-19 virus outbreak, it is prudent to establish the following restrictions:

Effective immediately, the physical facilities of the Village of Marcellus shall be closed to the public until April 3, 2020. The closure extends to all physical facilities owned by the Village of Marcellus including the Village Hall, Water Treatment Plant, and Village Highway Garage.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, I, John Curtin, Mayor of the Village of Marcellus, do hereby establish these restrictions as identified in this Order, effective at 7:30 P.M. on March 23, 2020.



DECLARATION OF A LOCAL
"STATE OF EMERGENCY"

"A STATE OF EMERGENCY" is hereby declared in the Village of Marcellus, County of Onondaga and State of New York for the period beginning at 7:30 on March 23, 2020, and continuing in effect until April 3, 2020. A State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions resulting from: the COVID-19 virus outbreak in and around the Village of Marcellus, affecting all or certain parts of the Village of Marcellus. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety and health of citizens of the Village of Marcellus.

As the Mayor of the Village of Marcellus, I, John Curtin, hereby exercise the authority given to me under the New York State Executive Law, Article 2B, to preserve the public safety, health and welfare and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Village.

I hereby direct all departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
