VILLAGE OF MARCELLUS DECLARATION OF A LOCAL "STATE OF EMERGENCY"

"A STATE OF EMERGENCY" declared in the Village of Marcellus, County of Onondaga and State of New York on March 23, 2020 is renewed for the period beginning at 7:30 on April 22, 2020, and continuing in effect for 30 days. A State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions resulting from: the COVID-19 virus outbreak in and around the Village of Marcellus, affecting all or certain parts of the Village of Marcellus. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety and health of citizens of the Village of Marcellus.

As the Mayor of the Village of Marcellus, I, John Curtin, hereby exercise the authority given to me under the New York State Executive Law, Article 2B, to preserve the public safety, health and welfare and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Village.

I hereby direct all departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
